

CNM Connect to Present Community Consulting for Nonprofits at the 2016 American Evaluation Association Summer Institute

DALLAS – June 23, 2016 – <u>CNM Connect</u> (CNM) today announced that Dr. Susan Wolfe, senior consultant for CNM, will deliver a workshop at the 2016 American Evaluation Association Summer Institute (AEA), entitled "Consulting in Communities for Nonprofits." The AEA Summer Institute is produced by the American Evaluation Association, the leading professional organization for evaluators in the U.S. This year's Institute will be held June 26 – 29, 2016 in Atlanta.

"It is an honor to be chosen by the AEA Summer Institute committee to present at this year's conference," said Wolfe. Attendees will learn how community consulting differs from other consulting disciplines and how to facilitate collaboration within community based organizations and among community members.
